1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They allow the website to remember your preferences and improve your experience.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

3.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function and cannot be disabled. They are usually set in response to actions you take, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms.

Legal basis: Article 6(1)(f) GDPR (legitimate interest in operating the website).

3.2 Analytics / Performance Cookies

These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. All information collected is aggregated and therefore anonymous.

Legal basis: Article 6(1)(a) GDPR (your consent).

3.3 Marketing / Social Media Cookies

These cookies may be set through our site by social media services such as Instagram, Facebook, TikTok and YouTube. They may be used to build a profile of your interests. They do not store personal information directly but work by uniquely identifying your browser.

Legal basis: Article 6(1)(a) GDPR (your consent).

4. Cookie Overview

Essential cookies

- Session cookies – maintain your session while browsing (deleted when browser closes).
- Cookie-consent cookie – remembers your cookie preferences (12 months).

Analytics cookies (with consent)

- Analytics platform cookies – help us understand how visitors interact with the site (up to 24 months).

Social media / marketing cookies (with consent)

- Third-party embed cookies – set when social media content is loaded.

5. Managing Your Cookie Preferences

You can manage or withdraw your consent for non-essential cookies at any time by clicking the 'Cookie Settings' link in the footer of our website.

You can also configure or disable cookies in your browser settings. Note that disabling some cookies may affect website functionality. For guidance on managing cookies in popular browsers:
