1. Controller

2. What Data We Collect

2.1 Data you provide directly

When you make a table reservation, send us an e-mail, subscribe to our newsletter or purchase a gift card, we collect the information you provide – such as your name, e-mail address, phone number and any message you include.

2.2 Data collected automatically

When you visit our website our server automatically logs your IP address, browser type, referring URL, pages visited and timestamps. This data is used solely for technical operation and security purposes and is deleted after 14 days.

2.3 Cookies & tracking

We use essential cookies required for the website to function and, with your consent, analytics cookies. Please refer to our Cookie Policy for full details.

3. Legal Basis for Processing

We process your personal data on the following legal bases under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR):

- **Article 6(1)(b) GDPR** – processing necessary to perform a contract (e.g. handling your reservation or gift-card purchase).
- **Article 6(1)(a) GDPR** – your consent (e.g. newsletter subscription, non-essential cookies).
- **Article 6(1)(f) GDPR** – our legitimate interests (e.g. website security and fraud prevention).

4. How We Use Your Data

We use your data to:

- process and confirm table reservations;
- respond to your enquiries;
- send our newsletter (only with your consent);
- process gift-card orders;

- improve our website and services.

5. Data Sharing

We do not sell your personal data. We share it only with:

- service providers who support our operations (e.g. reservation software WBV Software) under strict data-processing agreements;
- competent authorities when required by law.

6. Retention

We retain personal data only as long as necessary for the stated purpose or as required by Austrian statutory retention obligations (generally 7 years for business records).

7. Your Rights

Under the GDPR you have the right to:

- **access** the personal data we hold about you;
- **rectify** inaccurate data;
- **erase** your data ('right to be forgotten');
- **restrict** or **object** to processing;
- **data portability**;
- **withdraw consent** at any time without affecting prior processing.
